## **10 Safety Tips for Families**

## Before trick-or-treating, take five minutes to review these important safety tips from OCSD.

- Trick-or-treat with a trusted adult, or agree on a set route and curfew.
- Carry a flashlight or use reflective tape on costumes/outerwear.
- Walk, don't run, on sidewalks.
- If there are no sidewalks, walk facing traffic on the left side of the street.
- Only cross the street at designated crosswalks and obey traffic signals.
- Stay in familiar neighborhoods.
- Don't go into a stranger's home or car.
- Approach lighted houses only.
- Stay away from unknown pets or animals.
- Enjoy candy only after it has been checked by a trusted adult.
